We reserve approximately 20% of our seats for scholarships based on demonstrated financial need. To apply for a scholarship, which will cover the full program fee, please select which of the following criteria you meet and then upload the corresponding document to demonstrate your eligibility for a program scholarship. Scholarships will be provided, as available, to students who meet the eligibility requirements.

As we will refer to financial documents, it will be helpful to have your parent/legal guardian with you as you complete the next steps. It should not take longer than 10 minutes to complete

Scholarship Criteria

To receive a scholarship, which covers the full program fee, please confirm that you meet at least one of the following criteria:

1. **Family Income:** To be eligible for a program scholarship your household income must be at or below the applicable income level indicated in the chart below.
